There is little respite – between 10am and 6pm there was only one 50 minute session when we were neither playing nor timekeeping. Adapting technique and tactics to the indoor rules and conditions takes time, as the carpet is ultra fast and hoop approaches from anywhere other than dead in front can be somewhat unpredictable.

Subscriptions held for 2010

The subscription rates for 2010 are as follows:

Full membership	£45
CA levy	£7
Junior membership (under 16)	£10
16-18 or full time student	£20

- The CA levy is payable by all full members unless they are also members of another CA **registered** club and have nominated this club as their main club. Members of CA **affiliated** clubs have to pay the levy.
- There is a family membership option. If two adults in a family both take out full membership then any children under 16 from that family get free junior membership.
- If you want to pay your subscription using internet banking please confirm your intention to do so with Eric beforehand, and use sort code 20-05-74, account 80983861 (Wrest Park Croquet Club). Please make sure your name is referenced in the payment.
- The green fee for members' individual guests and any groups for which individual members are responsible remains at £3.60 per person per session. Please record these payments in the Visitor's Book in the pavilion. Members can bring three guests free of charge during the season.
- The green fee for independent visiting groups requiring a member to supervise them is now £5 per person and the member who is looking after the group can claim £20 expenses.

- Please do not write bookings on the calendar in the pavilion without letting me know first. There should be no need to book a lawn for casual play.

Signing in, car parking etc.

Last year's arrangements will continue for the time being. If you need to be reminded of these let me know. We have an annual pre-season review meeting with EH and if there are any changes they will be circulated to all members before the start of the season.

Social on 10 April from 11am

This will be an open day with opportunities for play and the chance to do a bit of spring cleaning. Food and drink will be provided. If you know anyone who is interested in joining the club, this would be an ideal opportunity to introduce them.

Early season coaching

We hope to offer some early season coaching for Association croquet and will circulate the details later.

If you want to improve your game there are few substitutes for taking two or three sets of old balls out onto the lawn and practising certain strokes, e.g. hoop approaches or split croquet strokes. It may sound boring but it builds confidence.

Golf croquet club tournaments

These events do not have to be restricted to Wrest Park members, so please ask players from local groups or clubs if they would like to take part.

Each tournament will need a manager who will be responsible for deciding the format and running the event. If anyone is willing to manage either tournament could he or she let me know as soon as possible.

Several clubs now offer open golf croquet handicap tournaments which are advertised in the CA Fixtures book. If you are interested in taking this idea further please contact a member of the Committee.

EACF/NT tournaments in 2010

Details of the National Trust golf croquet event will be made available once a new venue has been found. The NT short croquet tournament will be held at Bury St Edmunds – details to follow.

There is a level play golf croquet tournament at Ipswich on July 25. Entry limited to 14. If you are interested I can send you an application form
